# TCF Background



“ The idea for TCF grew from an need in for a simple, low cost event that gives those working in a tactical communications capacity the opportunity to meet, present and discuss key themes.

We recognised that the TDL domain was accommodated in terms of opportunities for peer-meetings, but that the scope was not broad enough to include many mission-critical, wider areas”

**TCF was developed with four main aims:**

- ▶ **Independent/voluntary organised**
- ▶ **Broaden the scope of discussion from a TDL focus to include wider, mission-critical Tactical Comms themes.**
- ▶ **To be impartial and low-cost to attend.**
- ▶ **To meet the exact requirements of attendees by ensuring that all attendees are able to contribute ideas.**
